

Notice to Installer:

1. See page 2 for specific product safety warnings.
2. Mounts directly over standard recessed 4" octagonal wiring box (by others).
3. LEDs are high-quality electronic components! Please avoid touching the light output opening of the LED directly during installation.
4. In order to avoid deformation under its own weight, do not place luminaire on its domed synthetic cover outside the package!
5. The luminaire may only be subjected to load when it is at rest - the steel wires are not suitable for any kind of moving dynamic load!

Installation: Pendant




Figure 1: Canopy Cover Removal

1. Loosen fixing nut of the canopy and remove mounting plate from canopy. [Figure 1]




Figure 2: Security Cable

2. Steel safety wire fixed to the back of the mounting plate must be firmly secured to suitable structural building component. [Figure 2]
3. Lead mains supply cable into 4" octagonal wiring box.
4. Make connections from driver to supply wiring:
 MAIN VOLTAGE SUPPLY WIRE TO BLACK DRIVER WIRE(S);
 NEUTRAL (COMMON SUPPLY WIRE TO WHITE DRIVER WIRE(S);
 GREEN GROUND WIRE TO GREEN DRIVER WIRE(S).
 Dimming (if applicable):
 DIMMING CONTROL WIRE (+) TO POSITIVE DRIVER DIM CONTROL WIRE
 DIMMING CONTROL WIRE (-) TO NEGATIVE DRIVER DIM CONTROL WIRE
5. Attach mounting plate with other suitable fixing material to the ceiling.




Figure 3: Steel Suspension Cables

6. Hook the ends of the 4 steel wires into the recesses of the mounting plate. [Figure 3]
7. Push the canopy onto the ceiling and screw tight to the mounting plate with the locking nut.

Installation: Cable Shortening

1. Electrical cabling must be shortened on the canopy end. The steel suspension cables must only be shortened at the pendant end
2. If steel cable needs to be cut, the end will need to be soldered in order to be reinserted into grip-lock connector.
3. Disconnect the luminaire from supply power.




Figure 4: Cable Shortening

4. Push steel cable into the steel ball located at the pendant side of the luminaire. [Figure 4]
5. Steel cable requires at least 4in to secure properly into steel ball. Please consider these 4in if cutting the cable to the required length.




Figure 5: Cable Extension (Generic Models)
